Costa Rica/ Hawaii Trip Leader Job Description

Overview

The Trip Leader for Sea Turtle Camp is a versatile and enthusiastic individual dedicated to supervising and educating teens in a marine science setting. Our program attracts academically strong participants who are selected through an application process. This role requires the ability to inspire, teach, and care for a group of 12–16 students while collaborating with a team.

Applicants should have a passion for marine conservation, youth education, and teamwork. The Trip Leader is responsible for delivering daily instruction, organizing activities, managing logistics, and driving campers safely. The role requires maintaining a high standard of safety, education, and fun while creating a life-enriching experience for every participant. This position reports to the Operations Director and Program Director.

Skills and Qualifications

Minimum Requirements

- Bachelor's degree (or enrollment in) marine biology, environmental science, or related field.
- ✤ At least 23 years old.
- Excellent physical condition.
- Certifications in Lifeguarding, CPR, and First Aid (or ability to earn before the program start date).
- Experience in marine science, environmental education, summer camps, or trip leading.
- Intermediate to advanced Spanish proficiency, with strong conversational skills (Costa Rica programs only).
- Strong organizational, logistical, and communication skills.
- Critical thinking and problem-solving abilities.
- Clean driving record and ability to pass a government background check.
- Availability for training (via Zoom or in person) and for the entire program duration with no conflicting commitments.

Desired Skills & Traits

- Master's degree in marine biology, environmental science, or education.
- Certifications in Wilderness First Aid.
- Hands-on experience with sea turtles or environmental education.
- High attention to detail and a clean, organized work approach.
- A positive, team-focused attitude with a love for inspiring youth.
- Ability to accept and provide constructive feedback.
- Resourcefulness and composure under pressure.
- Passion for healthy living, wellness, and marine conservation.

Responsibilities

Sea Turtle Camp operates two-week overnight marine biology trips in **Hawaii** and **Costa Rica** for teens aged 14–17. As a Trip Leader, you will work alongside 1–2 co-leaders to provide 24-hour supervision, marine biology education, and logistical management.

Key responsibilities include:

- Camper Supervision & Engagement: Build relationships with campers, oversee safety, administer medications, and provide emotional support.
- Instruction & Activities: Teach program curriculum, lead activities, and facilitate sunrise/sunset beach walks.
- Logistics & Coordination: Manage schedules, prepare equipment, and handle transportation (Hawaii only).
- Collaboration: Work closely with vendors, communicate with parents, and provide support to co-leaders.
- Safety & Emergency Response: Ensure all activities are conducted safely, and follow emergency procedures when needed.
- Program Implementation: Conduct pre-session preparations, oversee daily operations, and perform post-session cleanup and evaluations.
- Team Leadership: Attend meetings, provide feedback to team members, and uphold the camp's mission and high standards.

Compensation

- Weekly stipend: \$400-\$500, based on experience.
- Full travel package: airfare, accommodations, and meals during trips.
- Comprehensive training on Sea Turtle Camp's expectations, policies, and procedures.

Contract Duration

Sea Turtle Camp programs typically run from **late June to early August**. Candidates must attend mandatory pre-program training, which may take place via Zoom, phone, or in person.
