Key Responsibilities

Food Preparation and Service:

- ❖ Assist in the preparation of nutritionally balanced meals, snacks, and pack-out lunches.
- Cook using a variety of methods, such as boiling, broiling, steaming, and roasting.
- Prepare ingredients by washing, peeling, and chopping as needed.
- ❖ Bake bread, muffins, and desserts.
- Ensure proper food temperatures and assess food quality.
- Set up and serve food in a safe, efficient, and timely manner.

Sanitation and Inventory Management:

- Maintain a clean and organized kitchen, including food storage and preparation areas.
- Wash, sanitize, and maintain cooking equipment and dining hall supplies.

- Visual acuity required for close and distance tasks.

Compensation

- Starting stipend of \$700 per week, with adjustments based on experience.
- Additional compensation includes **ocean-view accommodations**, meals, and uniforms during the summer program, valued at approximately **\$5,000**.
- Completion and successful performance may lead to an end-of-season bonus.
- On-site training will cover company expectations, policies, and procedures.
- Local candidates with the ability to commute daily are welcome.

Contract Duration

This is a **seasonal position** that spans approximately 10 weeks, beginning with mandatory training in late May and concluding in early August. Candidates must commit to the entire duration of the program, including training and camp sessions.
