Key Responsibilities

- Supervise the daily operations of our residential camps, ensuring smooth implementation of activities, including surfing, marine science education, and evening programs.
- Collaborate with camp leadership to plan and facilitate staff training, ensuring all team members are aligned with camp standards.
- Provide logistical support for camper arrival and departure, manage camp inventory, and maintain camp facilities, including vehicles.
- Serve as a substitute counselor when needed, ensuring campers' needs are met and providing leadership in both structured and informal settings.
- ❖ Lead and oversee emergency procedures and safety drills, maintaining high standards of safety at all times.
- ❖ Act as a liaison between staff and the On-Site Director, fostering open communication and resolving issues in a timely and professional manner.
- Manage and organize the camp store, inventory, and any necessary repairs or replacements of camp equipment.
- Safely transport campers and staff as needed, following all safety guidelines.
- Ensure that camp policies, procedures, and safety standards are consistently followed by staff and campers.

Skills & Requirements

Minimum Requirements

- Bachelor's degree in Recreation Management, Leadership, Education, Counseling, or a related field.
- At least 3 years of experience working in a residential camp environment, with demonstrated leadership abilities.
- Must be 21 years of age or older.
- Strong physical stamina and fitness; ability to lift up to 35 pounds and work outdoors in summer conditions.
- Ability to obtain Lifeguarding, CPR, and First Aid certifications and pass a 500-yard open-ocean swim test.
- Excellent communication skills (both written and oral).
- Strong organizational, logistical, and problem-solving skills.
- Ability to manage multiple tasks and prioritize effectively in a fast-paced, dynamic camp environment.
- Proven ability to inspire and motivate a team, as well as manage staff conflict when necessary.
- Must be committed to working long hours and weekends during the camp season.

❖ Ability to reside on-site during the camp program (June 2 - August 2) with mandatory pre-camp training from May 24 - May 31.

- Master's degree in Psychology, Counseling, Recreation, or Education.
- Wilderness First Responder certification or higher.
- Experience in marine science, environmental education, or surfing instruction.
- Familiarity with local marine ecosystems and species.
- Environmental education certification or teaching credentials.
