SCUBA Camp Counselor Summer Position

Job Description

Overview

Sea Turtle Camp is seeking a passionate, service-oriented **Scuba Camp Counselor** to join our overnight programs. This role involves working closely with a team to inspire and guide academically motivated teens (ages 13-17) as they earn their **PADI Scuba Certifications** and gain hands-on marine science education.

As a Scuba Camp Counselor, you will facilitate engaging educational programs, oversee camper safety, and handle the logistics of daily activities. This role requires a proactive, energetic individual who can collaborate effectively with the **Unit Leader**, **Site Director**, and partners like **Aquatic Safaris**. If you're passionate about marine conservation, teaching, and youth mentorship, this is your chance to make a meaningful impact.

Key Responsibilities

Program Implementation

- Facilitate and participate in all camp activities, including marine science educational lessons, scuba safety instruction, and evening programs.
- Lead sunrise and sunset sea turtle nest walks with patrol groups.
- Ensure the implementation of a uniform and engaging curriculum for campers.
- Provide logistical support, including daily setup and breakdown of camp activities and maintaining supplies.

Camper Supervision & Safety

- Provide 24-hour supervision of campers, ensuring their well-being both in the bunk rooms and during field activities.
- Manage camper behavior with professionalism and empathy, addressing discipline issues as needed.

- Complete pre-session preparation, including reviewing camp binders, organizing supplies, and ensuring readiness for camper arrival.
- Perform post-session tasks, such as camp cleanup, inventory management, and evaluations.
- Help maintain a clean, organized work environment and oversee equipment inventory.
- Communicate professionally with camper parents, addressing questions and concerns during checkin/check-out.
