SCUBA Marine Educator Summer Position

Job Description

Overview

Sea Turtle Camp is seeking an enthusiastic and skilled **Scuba Marine Educator** to join our overnight program. This role involves inspiring, teaching, and guiding academically motivated teens (ages 13–17) as they earn their **PADI Scuba Certification** and gain hands-on marine science knowledge.

As a Scuba Marine Educator, you will work closely with the **Unit Leader**, **Site Director**, and a collaborative team to provide engaging educational programs, facilitate logistics, and ensure camper safety. This position is ideal for individuals passionate about marine stewardship, education, and youth mentorship.

Key Responsibilities

Program Implementation

- Teach and facilitate marine science curriculum, integrating engaging hands-on activities.
- Lead sunrise and sunset sea turtle nest walks with patrol groups.
- Oversee program logistics, including setup, breakdown, and inventory of supplies.
- Collaborate with the team to deliver a safe, fun, and enriching experience for all campers.

Camper Supervision & Safety

- Provide 24-hour supervision, ensuring camper well-being in both bunk rooms and field activities.
- Manage camper behavior with empathy and professionalism, addressing discipline issues as needed.
- Oversee medication administration, dietary preferences, and special needs to ensure inclusivity and comfort.
- Safely transport students in **15-passenger vans** for camp activities and excursions.

Team Collaboration

- Support the Unit Leader and Site Director by handling tasks and delegating responsibilities.
- Foster professional relationships with interns, volunteers, and staff at the Karen Beasley Sea Turtle Hospital.
- Participate in **daily team meetings**, discussing camper issues, schedules, and logistics.
- Provide constructive feedback to co-workers and assist in training and mentoring team members.

Administrative & Logistical Duties

- Complete pre-session preparation, including reviewing camp binders, organizing supplies, and ensuring readiness.
- Perform post-session tasks, such as cleanup, inventory management, and evaluations.
- Maintain a clean, organized workspace and monitor equipment inventory.
- Communicate professionally with camper parents, addressing questions and concerns during checkin/check-out.

Skills and Requirements Required

- BA or BS in Marine Biology, Environmental Science, Education, or a related field (or currently pursuing).
- At least 21 years of age and in excellent physical condition.
- Certifications in Lifeguarding, CPR, and First Aid (or willingness to obtain).
- Experience in **marine science**, **environmental education**, or youth-focused programs.
- Strong organizational, communication, and problem-solving skills.
- Clean driving record and ability to pass a government background check.
- No conflicting summer commitments, including travel or other obligations.

Preferred

- Master's degree in a relevant field.
- SCUBA Certification (Open Water or higher).
- Familiarity with local marine ecosystems and organisms.
- Teaching experience or environmental education certification.
- Enthusiastic, team-oriented, and committed to fun and excellence.
