SCUBA Unit Leader Summer Position Job Description

As the **Unit Leader**, you will manage day-to-day logistics, lead educational programming, and inspire campers to become stewards of the ocean. You will work closely with the **Site Director**, **Program Director**, and a talented team to oversee all activities, from scuba certification to evening programs. This position requires leadership, attention to detail, and a passion for marine science and youth education.

Key Responsibilities

Program Leadership

- Oversee and implement the camp's curriculum, ensuring activities align with Sea Turtle Camp's mission and high standards.
- Supervise all daily activities, from educational sessions to scuba training, maintaining consistency and excellence.
- Provide 24-hour supervision, ensuring camper safety and well-being both in the field and at camp facilities.

- Must be in excellent physical condition and able to lift 50 lbs unassisted.
- Strong organizational, communication, and problem-solving skills.
- Clean driving record and ability to pass a government background check.
- No conflicting summer commitments, including travel or other leave.

- Master's degree in a relevant field.
- * Wilderness First Responder Certification or higher.
- Familiarity with southeastern marine ecosystems and organisms.
- Teaching experience or environmental education certification.
- Extroverted, fun, and highly motivated team player with exceptional attention to detail.
